T-Mobile x BBBS Partnership

T-Mobile believes that access to education is access to opportunity. That's why they're offering **free internet and hot spots** to 10 million eligible households across the nation! Applying takes less than 10 minutes, and now Big Brothers Big Sisters has partnered with T-Mobile to make the application process even easier.

Accepted families will receive 100GB of mobile data per year for 5 years and a mobile hotspot at no cost, plus the opportunity to purchase additional Wi-Fi devices at a low cost. To be eligible, families must have a student enrolled in the National School Lunch Program or receive benefits such as CalFresh, Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT or P-EBT), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or Medicaid.





Families and Children Together (FaCT) Family Resource Centers

Throughout Orange County there is a network of Family Resource Centers (FRCs) — 16 to be exact! Each FRC is a family-friendly, community-based site that provides access to comprehensive prevention and treatment-oriented social, educational, and health services for all families, including birth, blended, kinship, adoptive and foster families. Core services include:

- Counseling
- Parent education
- Family and emergency support
- Information and referrals
- Case Management Team
- Domestic Violence Personal Empowerment program
